The University of Coimbra, added by UNESCO to its World Heritage list thanks to a monumental architectural complex but also due to its important role in the spreading of Portuguese language and culture, preserves representative educational elements of Portuguese history and culture, like toys and traditional games.

Studies carried out throughout the world show that the use of toys and traditional games in recreational, relational, educational and emotional levels are common to all European and world cultures. That fact stresses the recreational dimension of humankind, as well as the necessity of developing studies related to toys and traditional games, as already recognized by UNESCO in the Universal Declaration on Cultural Diversity (1989), the Recommendation on the Safeguarding of Traditional and Popular Culture (2001), and Rapport sur l'opportunité préliminaire et la portée d'une Charte internationale des jeux et des sports traditionenels (2005). Games and traditional toys are socially recovering their importance as a way to preserve and spread knowledge and culture, but also as a means of conveying different values, preparing individuals for the challenges brought by contemporary societies, more globalized, plural, ethnic and cultural.

- 3 Address the implication of the game and traditional toy as active elements in the transmission of values and in cultural preservation;

- 5 Promote the dissemination of the importance and effectiveness of games, fights and traditional toys as educational elements;
- 6 -Promote knowledge of recreational diversity.
